August 2024 Online	"Get-to-know-you" mixer with the research team and potential researchers that will help you with your problem/opportunity of practice
September 2024 Online	 Coach and researcher meetings: Separate coach meetings to aid in thinking about the problem/opportunity of practice for your school Working with your researcher to create a conjecture map that will aid in helping teachers in your school/district in understanding the problem of practice
October 2024 In person	Researchers and coaches meet together to create a map that assists with helping teachers address the problem of practice in action.
November 2024 - March 2025 In person	School visit where researchers gain an understanding of classroom and school contexts
April 2025 Online	Coach and researcher separately debrief about school visits.
July/August 2025 In person	Summer Writing Retreat: Researchers and coaches will briefly write about their chosen problem of practice and how it was implemented at your school/district and any successes and/or challenges that occured
